The Role of OFSTED in Improving the UK Education System

The Office for Standards in Education, Children's Services and Skills (OFSTED) is a UK government department responsible for improving learning standards and quality in educational institutions. They inspect state and private schools, colleges, childcare, nurseries, and other learning providers in England.

Their recurring reports establish school ratings that are essential to parents, employers, and learners. These reports include information on the quality of education and management, as well as learning performance and teaching results in each institution.



What's New in OFSTED School Ratings

From autumn 2025, the <u>new OFSTED framework</u> introduces two significant changes to school ratings, in addition to new inspection rating cards: a refreshed grading scale and evaluation areas.

The new 5-grade system includes the following categories:

- 1. Urgent improvement
- 2. Needs attention
- 3. Expected standard
- 4. Strong standard
- 5. Exceptional

OFSTED reports will cover six evaluation areas:

- 1. Safeguarding (met/not met)
- 2. Inclusion (5-grade scale)
- 3. Curriculum and teaching (5-grade scale)
- 4. Achievement (5-grade scale)
- 5. Attendance and behaviour (5-grade scale)
- 6. Personal development and well-being (5-grade scale)

The OFSTED ranking has been adjusted in response to feedback from parents and education professionals. It aims to raise standards, focus on the needs and well-being of teachers, and support the engagement of parents and school staff.

Inspections under the rating reform will begin in November 2025 for state-funded and early years schools, and in January 2026 for initial teacher education and non-association independent schools.

SAFEGUARDING

Strengthen Children's Safety with Secure Google Workspace Management


Goal: Ensure Student Online Safety during Remote Learning

GAT Features:

• **GAT Shield**, as a <u>security Chrome extension</u>, allows real-time monitoring of each student's activity, detecting inappropriate online content and DLP risks. It also <u>tracks</u> <u>the location of students' devices</u> when they are learning from home using Chromebooks and generates alerts when the user signs in outside the specified area.

Goal: Monitor Online Activity and Trigger Real-Time Alerts

- GAT+ enables <u>content search</u> across your domain, allowing you to find specific text within images, videos, comments, and file content of every user and group. It enables quick action if inappropriate content is found. You can also <u>set up alerts</u> for potential account takeover attempts to proactively secure your users.
- **GAT Shield** monitors all browser activity, providing real-time alerts on all sites and users. Extended reporting functionality includes user summary, chats, downloads, and <u>searches</u>. Customizable alert rules allow complete monitoring of student online safety.






Goal: Detect Cyberbullying and Child-on-Child Harm Online

GAT Features:

• **GAT Shield** provides the option to set <u>alerts for inappropriate</u>, <u>harmful</u>, <u>and</u> <u>disrespectful language</u> used by pupils and other users in Gmail, chat, documents, or on visited pages. You can choose a custom alert scope and exclusions, as well as a template for inspecting page content.



Goal: Enforce Student Online-Safety Policies

GAT Features:

• GAT Shield enables admins to block specific URLs or to block all websites and allow only particular sites access in the Chrome browser. Safe Search, when enabled, excludes explicit content (including images) from search results. That helps schools protect their students online and stay alerted when they attempt to break a school rule.


The same tool <u>controls user</u> <u>login</u> into the school domain with a specific rule. For more security, it logs the user out when particular criteria aren't met.





Goal: Monitor Staff Behaviour and Well-Being

- GAT+ generates weekly reports for all Google Workspace users, including teachers, that show their activity across the domain, internal collaboration, top email senders, and the number of new documents, among other metrics. You can also schedule a report file shared externally from the teachers' Organisation Unit and another one for teachers' emails. School principals and inspectors can conduct staff performance evaluations based on this data.
- GAT Shield shows specific staff member <u>browsing activity</u>, including overall browsing activity, total time spent, and a list of the URLs visited. This helps to detect potential well-being issues early and maximise teaching effectiveness.






CURRICULUM AND TEACHING

Increase Teaching Standards via Real-Time Classroom Monitoring

Goal: Track E-Learning Progress and Personalise Support

GAT Features:

Teacher Assist allows teachers to have full control over their own classes, while
principals can supervise and monitor teacher-led sessions and track their progress. The
"Principal" feature provides access to detailed information on student engagement,
teaching methods, and overall effectiveness, both retrospectively and in real time.




• GAT+ gives domain super admins full visibility into submitted classwork via the Student Submission Summary. This data, shared with teachers, can help them evaluate student effectiveness and make decisions about personalised learning if needed.



Goal: Safeguard Learning Integrity and Monitor Assignments

GAT Features:

• <u>Taskmaster</u>, integrated with Google Classroom, evaluates whether student assignments submitted via Google Docs have been created independently or using AI chatbots. Additionally, based on AI algorithms, it detects when someone other than a student has written their assignment.




• **GAT Shield** blocks or customises access to artificial intelligence sites for pupils. School admin can fully modify the list of blocked websites as well as the level of access for a specific grade or student group, according to their needs. This restriction prevents plagiarism and ensures the originality of student classwork, while encouraging critical thinking, creativity and the smart use of AI tools.



Goal: Manage Classroom Resources Efficiently

GAT Features:

 Teacher Assist allows teachers to <u>access students' Drives</u> during virtual classroom sessions. It includes dedicated folders for student assignments created via Google Classroom.



After finding a Google Classroom group that was automatically generated from a Google Classroom, the admins can use it to share specific files with the pupils.

- GAT+ enables school admins to <u>add and update guardians</u> for the students in Google Classroom in bulk. This feature streamlines classroom management, helps student progress monitoring and eases teacher workload.
- <u>Taskmaster</u> allows teachers to assign a Google Doc file as classwork to each student. Teachers get notified once the student has submitted the assignment.




ATTENDANCE AND BEHAVIOUR

Foster Student Engagement with User Activity Tracking

Goal: Monitor Student Behaviour During Lessons

- GAT Shield shows school admins the <u>online activity</u> of each student in Google
 Classroom and detects cyberbullying, harassment, and derogatory language.
 Additionally, the admin can <u>block specific content sections</u>, such as comments or related videos on YouTube. Student behaviour monitoring and content blocking help reduce distractions, keeping students safe and focused on the class.
- Teacher Assist with its <u>Site Access Control History</u> feature allows for monitoring school URL policies compliance. It checks whether teachers remove or add a URL rule on their end in Teacher Assist. Real-time screen monitoring supports teachers in detecting misbehaviour, decreases the risk of lesson disruption and allows a prompt reaction.






Goal: Track Student Attendance

GAT Features:

• **Teacher Assist** enables teachers to easily review whether a student was absent or present in a Classroom on specific days. <u>The attendance report</u> shows each student's data as well as the number of students in a particular classroom and the time spent in each session.






Goal: Respond Quickly to Student Misbehaviour

GAT Features:

• **Teacher Assist**, showing student browsing activity in real time, gives teachers an option to take a prompt, personalised reaction during the Classroom session. They can open a new tab, switch between tabs, block or share a page—everything on the screen of an individual student or the entire group.



To maintain student focus on the class, teachers can <u>close</u> all browsing tabs that students viewed and <u>take screenshots</u> of their current browsing activity in Google Classroom. On the other hand, <u>locking</u> students' screens during the exams supports learning integrity and prevents cheating.





Goal: Monitor Student Mental Health Signals

GAT Features:


• **GAT Shield** empowers schools to restrict student access to harmful and ageinappropriate content, such as <u>deepfake nude apps</u> and pictures and <u>suicide content</u>. It decreases the risk of sexual abuse, self-harm and cyberbullying, promotes critical thinking and develops moral values. An access attempt triggers an alert notification.





Goal: Track Personal Development and Well-Being

- GAT+ provides detailed <u>Classroom insights</u>, allowing for a deep evaluation of student learning performance during class. Admins can review each student's grades and browsing activity up to 187 days (if GAT Shield is deployed to students' accounts) and track their progress.
- **Teacher Assist** can <u>automatically generate</u> Classroom PDF reports after every session and send them by email to teachers.
